

Shelter Rules

- The Pet Friendly Shelter is available to Palm Beach County residents who reside in mandatory evacuation zones or in mobile homes. Proof of residency in Palm beach County is required and space is limited. Restrictions apply and reservations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Pet owners are required to stay at the shelter with their pets unless they are pre-registered and staying at the Special Needs Shelter at the Fairgrounds.
- The shelter can accept dogs, cats, birds, and small pocket pets. Livestock, reptiles, and dangerous or vicious dogs will not be accepted.
- We reserve the right to refuse entry to aggressive animals.
- Weapons, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, furniture and large coolers are not allowed into the shelter.
- Shelter guests must provide their own sleeping bags, bedding and personal toiletries. Due to limited space (3' by 5' area), only essential necessities will be allowed. Large items and items not considered essential will not be permitted.

- Pet owners must provide appropriate sized kennels or carriers for their pets, as well as food for 5 days, bowls, bedding, litter box and litter, medications, treats, and toys..
- Once the storm/disaster has passed, the Pet Friendly Shelter will be immediately closed and all people and pets will be required to leave.
- Shelter Quiet Time is from 9pm to 9am. Please remember that everyone needs to rest, including our furry and feathery friends.
- Pet care schedules are posted by the entrances to the animal rooms. We ask that Pet owners adhere to the posted schedule so as to give everyone time to visit and care for their pets.
- Meal are provided by the Red Cross and times will be announced.
- Food and drinks are prohibited in the gymnasium.
- The Red Cross representatives are available to assist with minor First Aid issues. See any Shelter Worker wearing a vest for assistance.

- Palm Beach County Animal Care and Control Division and the Public Safety Department will not be responsible for illnesses or diseases which may be contracted during your and your pet's stay.
- Please keep valuable items out of sight or on your person at all times. The Pet Friendly Shelter and its affiliates cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- While staying at the shelter, please follow all instructions and be respectful of other guest's spaces. Children should be supervised at all times.
- Appropriate attire is required at all times, including shirts and shoes.
- The shelter does not supply any personal hygiene, baby care supplies, medicine,
