























Larvae of **C. hominivorax** usually produce a bag-shaped, deep wound, feed gregarious on living tissues, are seen with their head pointed downward and do not move far on the surface.

Myiasis caused by the larva of **C. macellaria** feed on necrotic tissue, migrating considerably around the edges of the wound and in long haired animals, on the hair or wool around it, without producing a bagshaped wound.
