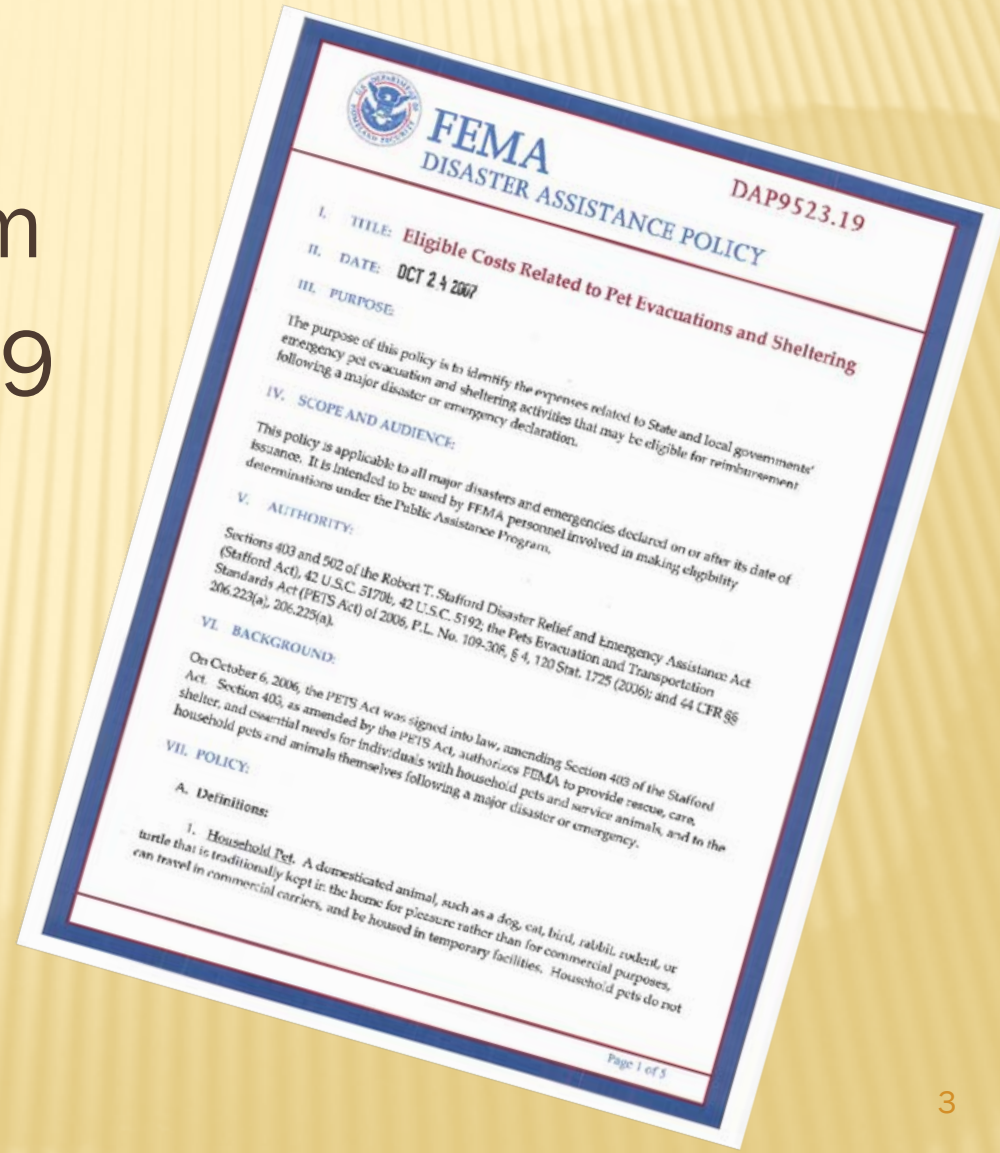

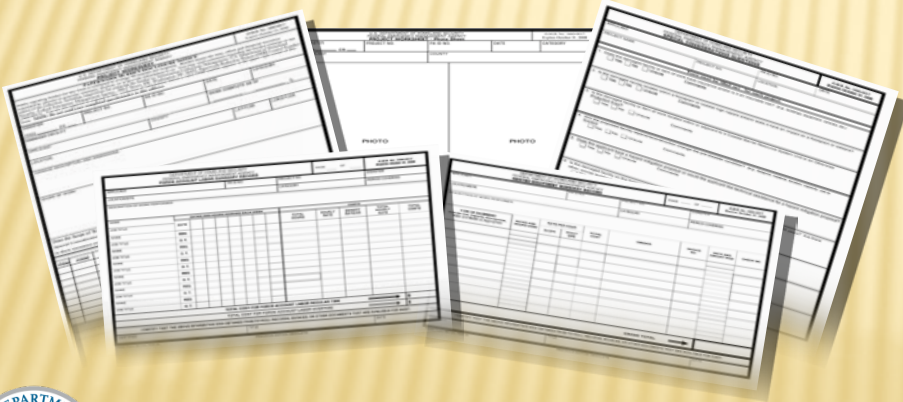

- Animals covered:
 - Service Animals
- Sheltered with their owners in congregate shelters.

- Work Covered:
 - Facilities
 - Supplies and Commodities
 - Labor
 - OT for Applicant
 - ST and OT for contract labor
 - Equipment
 - Emergency Veterinary Services

HOW DO WE DO IT/PAY FOR IT?

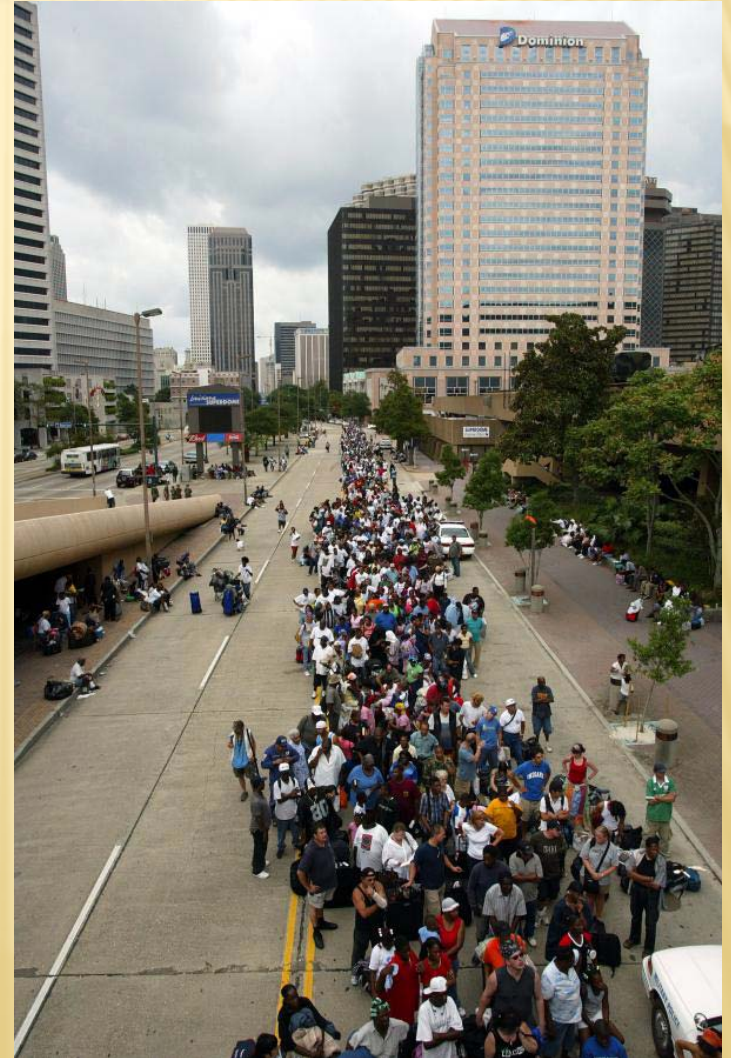
- Work Covered Cont'd:
 - Transportation
 - Shelter Safety and Security
 - Cleaning and Restoration
 - Removal and Disposal of Animal Carcasses (Pets)
 - Cataloging/Tracking System

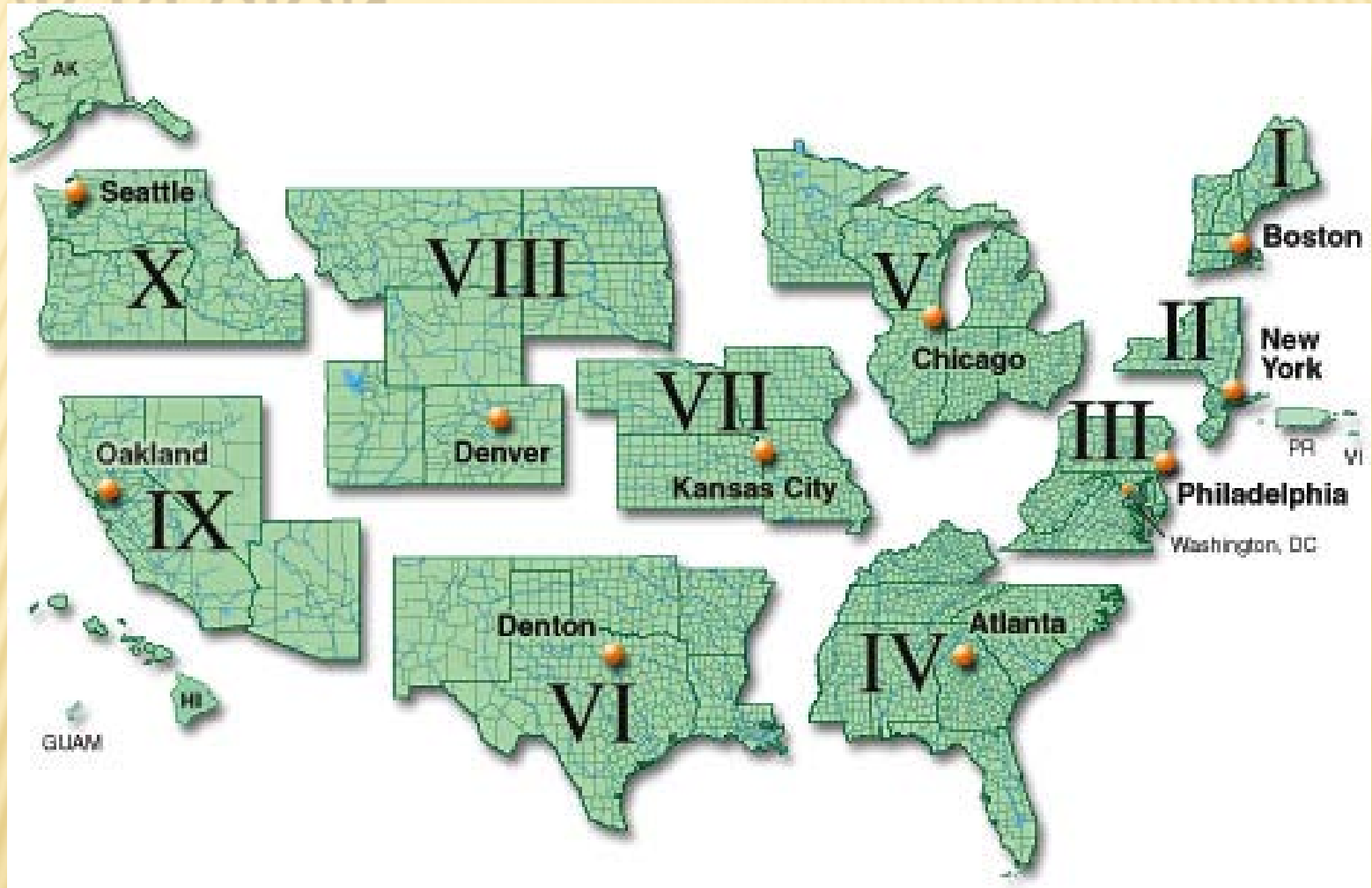
WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

- Pets Act of 2006
 - Requires communities to incorporate the needs of households with pets into emergency plans
 - Provides for reimbursement
